- **Explore short-form storytelling** methods used in digital and social media reporting.
- **Create a story** that may be published in Northeast Ohio.
- **Earn \$250** if your content is published.
- **Participate in a panel discussion** to share what you learned from the project.

Who: Aspiring high school journalists with some basic reporting skills or a keen interest in digital journalism

When: June 7-25 (excluding Saturdays and Sundays) from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Where: Your favorite spot to learn. This is a virtual workshop. Assistance for WiFi connection is available.
